

Public Notice

Canadian Navigable Waters Act

ArcelorMittal Infrastructure Canada G.P. (« AMIC ») hereby gives notice that a submission has been added to the Common Project Search pursuant to the *Canadian Navigable Waters Act* described herein and its description.

Pursuant to paragraph 4(1) of the said Act, ArcelorMittal Infrastructure Canada G.P. has deposited a notification of a minor work, in accordance with the requirements set out on the External Submission Site, on the online Common Project Search Registry (<http://cps.canada.ca/>) and under registry number 10898, a description of the following work:

- Dredging 2024 at the Port-Cartier harbour facilities (AMIC) ;
- In, on, under or across the Gulf of St. Lawrence (Province of Quebec) ;
- In Port-Cartier, in or near lot numbers 4 694 357 and 4 694 349.

As this is a notice of minor works and is compliant, the project is not subject to public comment and does not require approval from the Navigation Protection Program.
